TAP Overview for 2014B

The Telescope Access Program (TAP) is a program to give astronomers based in China direct access to competitive instrumentation on intermediate- and large-aperture optical/infrared telescopes. We estimate that the following amount of time will be available for new programs on four facilities:

Canada-France-Hawaii Telescope (3.6m): 45 hours

Palomar Hale Telescope (5.1m, P200): 9 nights

MMT Telescope (6.5m): 6 nights (1.5D/1G/1.5B)

Magellan (6.5m): 2 nights (1D/1B)

Proposal Submission

TAP is now accepting observing proposals up until the deadline. Proposals for CFHT time should be uploaded directly to the CFHT Northstar Proposal Tool.
